*Recommendation that **Approval** be given as follows:*

- I. Amendment No. 1 to Reimbursement Agreement for the Deer Creek Greenway Agreement between the Metropolitan Parks and Recreation District, dba The Great River Greenway District, and the City of St. Louis. This amendment modifies the terms of the original agreement to revise the DBE goals to 0%, as authorized by ordinance No. 71700.
- II. Amendment No. 2 to the Facilities Management Division's Elevator Service Contract No. 75042, with Overhead Door Company, extending the contract termination date through May 31, 2026, and increasing the maximum not-to-exceed amount from \$1,000,000 to \$2,000,000.
- III. Missouri Historical Society requests the Board of Public Service to accept artifact donations to add to the city's collection in the Soldiers Memorial Military Museum.
- IV. Professional Service Agreement (PSA) No. 1307 with AECOM Hunt Clayco for Construction Management at Risk services for the New Concourse and Terminal Program at St. Louis Lambert International Airport, for the maximum agreement amount of \$8,308,738.00.
- V. Professional Service Agreement (PSA) 1308 with Alberici, Tarlton, and KAI for Construction Management at Risk services for CTP Garage and Roadways at St. Louis Lambert International Airport, for the maximum agreement amount of \$3,631,713.00.
